Public release of generative AI products and large language models (LLM), including GPT-3 and ChatGPT, has triggered a flurry of news in recent years among non-technical people, MT proponents, and human translators, who are alternately excited and concerned about the uses of these services. Mary will draw on her decade of experience as a freelancer working with large LSPs and individual clients and her experience as a project manager in the MT and human translation areas to build a picture of the global localization industry for individual human translators to understand changes and trends.
